


February 18, 1956--KINY-TV will start limited programming Sunday afternoon unless unforeseen additional troubles develop. William J. Wagner, owner, explained that there are many bugs that must be ironed out before KINY-TV can deliver a perfect picture. He is sorry for the delays but pointed out that all new TV stations go through this stage. Wagner said that from a technical standpoint it would be far better to wait until everything was perfect before going on the air but it might be quite some time. February 20, 1956--William J. Wagner owner of KINY-TV said reception on television last night was beyond the station's expectations... "really excellent because we were not ready for it."

I hope that the public understands that the TV picture we will transmit at the beginning is not a comparison of the quality that will be forthcoming. Until our regular antenna atop the KINY-TV tower on the Rock Dump can be corrected, we will have to operate on a temporary antenna and power delivered to individual sets will be only one tenth as strong. There are also many technical things that must be corrected before KINY-TV will be ready to deliver a perfect picture.

Programs ran from 6:00 PM until 10:00 PM last night, leading off with a talk by Wagner and a news broadcast by Dick Peter. The station will be on the air barring difficulties every night from now on with programs beginning at 6:45 PM. The test pattern will be shown at 5:00 PM, to enable viewers to line up their sets. *Daily Alaska Empire*
